The 6th Annual Marshfield Cultural Fair, “All Related, Each Unique” will be held February 28, 2009 on the University of Wisconsin-Marshfield/Wood County Campus, 2000 W. 5th Street, Marshfield, Wisconsin. A highlight will be The Human Race Machine, which uses computer technology to show participants the characteristics of six different races mapped onto their own image.

From 10 am to 4 pm Saturday, February 28 experience music, dance, international foods, and displays by local organizations, businesses, educational groups, and individuals. There are activities for all, including crafts, games, educational programs and a children’s area. The themes for the fair are cultural and ethnic diversity and international connections. The 2009 Marshfield Cultural Fair activities are preceded Friday evening, February 27 with a performance by the Natarpana Dance Company at 7:30 pm in the Helen Connor Laird Theater.
